Weekly Consultation and Support

Our behavior analysts will help design a program to address the specific needs of your family. Whether you need help addressing skill deficits like potty training, safety awareness, or self-management, or you need help reducing severe problem behaviors, like aggression, our behavior analysts are here to help.

With Holdsambeck & Associates, Inc., you will receive weekly consultations with your personal behavior analyst to provide support and services addressing those behaviors or behavioral deficits you identify as most troubling.

As part of this service, you will receive a complete **Functional Behavior Assessment** of the behaviors you identify as the most important in addition to a corresponding **Behavior Intervention Plan** detailing the recommendations for implementing intervention.

Using a parent education model, our services include several levels. Services may be weekly consultations, or involve more intensive interventions with a behavior analyst visiting you and your family multiple times a week to directly address identified behaviors.

What areas of behavior may this service cover?

Reducing problems such as Aggression, Self-Injury, Tantrums, Food Refusal, and Trouble Cooperating.

Increasing Communication, Social behavior, Verbal Behavior, Safety behavior, Functional Independence, and Self-care.
